Vaccine Definition Modified

The definition of a vaccine was changed by the CDC: Pre 2015- ...prevent the disease; 2015-2021 ...**Produce immunity** to a specific disease; September 2021 ... protection from a specific disease. The State of Alaska definition in statute has not changed: A vaccine means...increasing **specific immunity** to life threatening and disabling diseases. Comirnaty is the only partially approved COVID shot and is not readily available in the U.S. All other COVID shots are under Emergency Use Authorization only and cannot be mandated. There have been an estimated 15 court cases won against the COVID shot mandates nationwide.

Standing Up

In Judiciary, Health & Social Services, State Affairs, and on the Senate floor, I worked tirelessly to protect individual rights, ensure people weren't denied Public Access based on vaccine status, protecting employment, including ensuring people were not discriminated against based on vaccination status. We will continue to fight for your liberty and medical freedom.

The Budget

I have a long track record for advocating for a smaller budget. Within my four sub-finance committees there was little appetite for cuts, which led me to a no vote on the bloated budget. I've looked for creative ways to decrease the size of government, following the statute with regards to the PFD, and fighting for the highest PFD possible.



I had the distinct honor of presenting at the Early Treatment Summit Legal Medical Rights. I presented on topics such as Emergency Use Authorization, Informed Consent, and Medical Bill of Rights.
